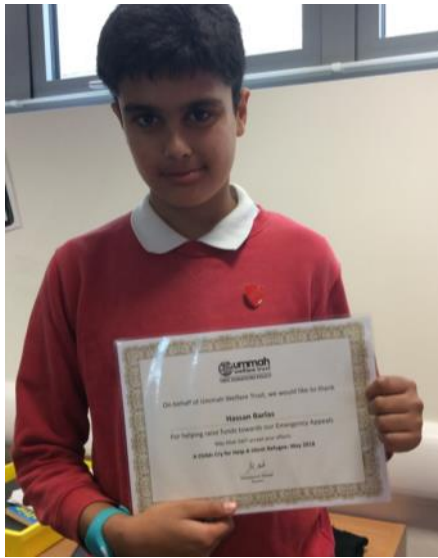

## Changes to Data Protection Law May 2018

You may be aware that from 25<sup>th</sup> May, the rules around data protection are changing. The 'General Data Protection Regulation' (GDPR) will change how we can use your personal data and how we keep it safe. It will also strengthen your rights over your own data.

The reason for this is to make sure sensitive or private information about yourselves and your children stays safe. Whilst it is similar to the current Data Protection Act in many ways, there are a few differences, so we need to make a few changes at the school in order to ensure that we remain compliant.

One of these changes is that we have updated our privacy notice which can be found on the schools website ([www.kensingtonavenueprimary.co.uk](http://www.kensingtonavenueprimary.co.uk)) under statutory information.

As part of our work to comply with GDPR, we will also be continuing to use your contact details for any school communication.
