As Scientists we will:

learn about food groups, and why we need certain foods for growth and to give us energy; discover what nutrients the human body needs, and in what proportions; learn about what herbivores, carnivores and omnivores eat; study animals and their diets; and identify major bones in the human body as well as compare human skeletons to those of other animals.

In R.E we will:

be looking at Christianity this half term. The children will have opportunities to understand the significance of Jesus in the Christian faith.

We will also be looking closely at the Hindu faith and their ways of celebrating Diwali.

As readers we will:

focusing on reading with intonation and expression. We will also be working on our comprehension skills and understanding the importance of getting the information from the text.



What did the Romans leave for us?

In computing:

As computing Technicians we will be using J2E Data to purposefully create, organise, store, manipulate and retrieve digital content. We will design and create a range of programs, systems and content that accomplish given goals.

As musicians we will:

be exploring sounds. We will also be singing a selection of songs with expression and learning how music can be organised through sequences. We will also learn songs for Christmas! 

As Athletes we will:

be looking at different types of dance and how to express different feelings through movement. We will also be working on controlling their balance and flexibility through dance.



As authors we will:

be looking at different genres of writing.

These genres include: letter writing, myth writing, persuasive writing and creating their own comic strips.

In order to achieve this, we will be enjoying a range of different stories including the books 'Leon and Bob' and 'Gregory Cool' as well as focusing on Myths and Legends linked to the Romans.

We will continue to improve and apply our grammar in our writing. We will focus on using fronted adverbials, adverbs, identifying main and subordinate clauses and applying possessive apostrophe with singular nouns and regular nouns.

As Artists we will:

be improving our mastery of art and design techniques, including drawing, sketching and painting. We will be linking art work with our Literacy activity as well as our Learning Journey question.



As Citizens we will:

Be looking at what makes a good friend and how to deal with tricky situations in friendships. As a school we will all take part in Anti-bullying week and complete activities based around this.

As Mathematicians we will:

be learning about 2D and 3D shapes, properties of shapes and their lines of symmetry. We will also learn about money, identifying angles, measuring length and adding fractions.
