
What is out of our control?

As readers we will be looking at the meaning of unfamiliar words and developing our comprehension skills.

As authors we will be using the amazing story of Shackleton's great expedition to the Antarctic. Whilst reading this text we will be completing a recount, diary entries, an explanation text and writing a persuasive letter.



As historians we will be using photos and artefacts to devise questions about natural disasters of the past and how we have tried to protect ourselves from natural disasters.

As mathematicians we will be continuing to focus on multiplication table and related division facts. During the next half term as a year group, we will be completing skills tests, the results of which we are sure your children will tell you! The main topics will be reading scales, ratio and proportion, probability and converting weights.

As computing technicians we will explore Spiderman's motto, "With great power comes great responsibility," through the lens of digital citizenship. We will create online comic strips to show a digital superhero who witnesses an act of poor digital citizenship and then helps to resolve it.

As geographers we will be studying natural disasters that occur in our world, looking at their locations, causes and effects on human life. Using atlases we will be developing skills to read grid references and use the eight point compass to give directions.

As citizens we will be looking at the topic of friendship. We will focus on how to behave responsibly, recognise how our actions affect others and how others have lived their lives in the past.

As athletes we will continue to develop our sporting skills with the Sports Coach.

As scientists we will be understanding the elements of 'Light' We will look at how the parts of the eye help us to see as well as carry out investigations involving light and shadows
