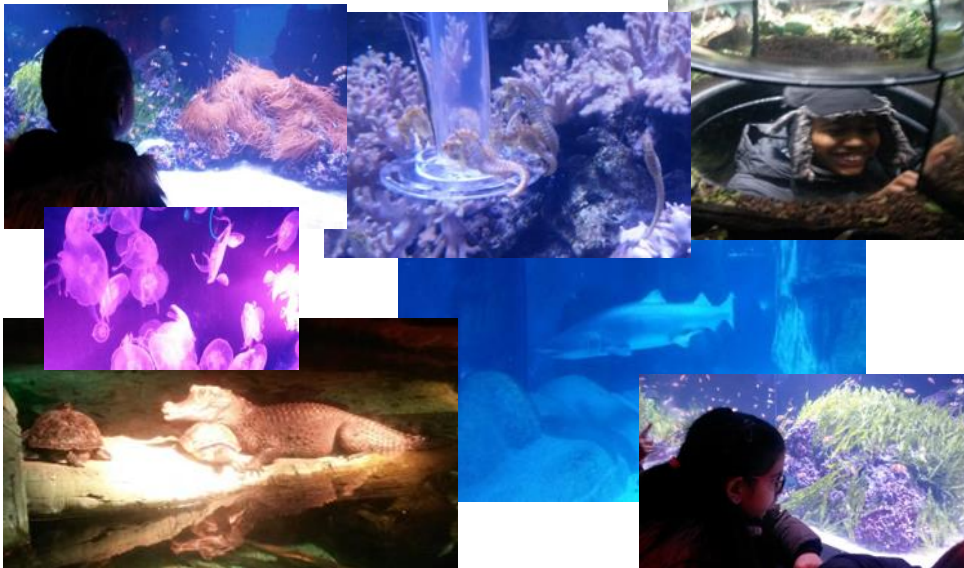

Corona Virus UPDATE

We are continuing to keep you updated on the government's response to COVID-19 (Coronavirus).

Advice for those who have travelled recently.

If you have returned from the following specific areas since 19th February, you should call NHS 111 and stay indoors and avoid contact with other people even if you do not have symptoms:

- Iran
- Specific lockdown areas in Northern Italy:
In the Lombardy Region: Bertonico, Casalpusterlengo, Castelgerundo, Castiglione D'Adda, Codogno, Fombio, Maleo, San Fiorano, Somaglia, Terranova dei Passerini
- In the Veneto Region: Vo
- Special care zones in South Korea : Daegu and Cheongdo
- Hubei province (returned in the past 14 days)

If you have returned from the following areas since 19 February and develop symptoms, however mild, you should stay indoors at home and avoid contact with other people immediately and call NHS 111:

- Northern Italy (defined above, and not including, Pisa, Florence and Rimini)
- Vietnam
- Cambodia
- Laos
- Myanmar

If you have a cough, or fever or shortness of breath and have visited any of the following areas in the last 14 days, stay indoors and call NHS 111 informing them of your recent travel:

- China, apart from Hubei province
- Thailand
- Japan
- Republic of Korea, apart from special care zones (listed above)
- Hong Kong
- Taiwan
- Singapore
- Malaysia
- Macau



PE Kits

Zig Zag Lines....

Yellow zig zag road markings are placed to show that the area must be kept clear to allow an unrestricted view for approaching drivers, cyclists or children wanting to cross the road.

We politely ask parents **not to wait or park** on these lines or across out neighbours driveways for

the safety of all the children at the school. It may take a few extra minutes to park up safely, but it helps ensure the safety of all the children by reducing congestion and enabling visibility.
