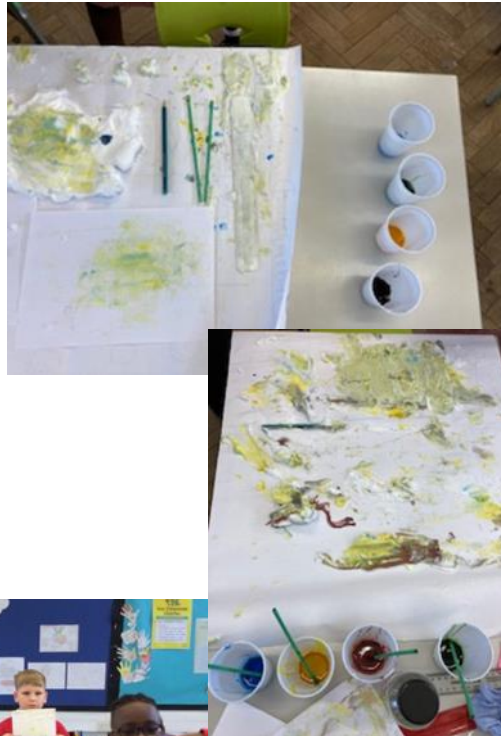
In September we welcome back Miss Islam who will be the new teacher for R Bluebell after completing her teacher training.
