

(Children will not all have the same activities)




Class routines and rules

Curriculum for next Half-Term

The first week of term is 'Healthy Us' week when we focus on keeping healthy and keeping safe. All learning will be based around 'healthy us'.

We will then start our new topic.

Our topic is Splendid Skies– 'What's going on outside?'

Imagine floating high above land and sea on a bed of clouds, silently sweeping by on a billowing breeze. Back down to earth, let's take a walk outdoors. But what should we wear? Wellington boots? A sun hat? Maybe a warm coat? How do we know what the weather will be like today? Read and write poems and postcards, and, if you don't like today's weather report, why not write your own? Make a weather station to find out more about the weather in your area. What weather do you prefer? Sunshine, snow, storms or showers? Get your wellies on and let's go.

Art Children will make paintings and drawings of the weather outside. They will explore ways of making temporary clouds using flour or more permanent cloud sculptures using cloud dough. They will make season trees and sun catchers.

Literacy We will be writing recounts about what we experience outside. We will listen to poems about the weather and write descriptions. We will be writing postcards and weather reports.

Numeracy We will be learning about addition and subtraction, measuring weight and capacity and investigating shapes.


Science We will be investigating the weather, including making a rain gauge, measuring temperature and playing with shadows.

PE We will be developing our throwing and catching skills

Computing As Computing Technicians we will be learning how to 'Keep Safe Online', we will be talking about how we can go to exciting places on the Internet, but we need to follow certain rules to remain safe.

In our speech and language groups we will be playing games to help us ask and answer questions.

As part of our occupational therapy programme we will continue to work on our core muscles and fine motor skills.
