Dear Parents/ Carers,

You may now be aware that the Government has announced that schools will not be fully open to all pupils until 8th March 2021 at the earliest. Remote learning will therefore continue up to and after the February half-term break.

We understand that remote learning brings a number of challenges for families and we invite you to complete a survey that will help us understand more where the challenges lie and what we may be able to do to make it easier and more accessible.

Many families who have found access to Wi-Fi and/or devices difficult have been able to borrow a device from school provided by the DfE. If you have requested a device and are waiting to hear from us, please note that we will do so as soon as the laptops have been set-up and configured.

A reminder that for families with the need to access more data the school can arrange this with the following providers: EE; O2; Sky; SMARTY; Tesco; 3; Virgin and Vodafone. We will need the account holders name, the network and the phone number in order for us to be able to process this through the DfE on your behalf. Please contact the office should this be of interest to you.
