We really hope everyone is continuing to stay safe during this really difficult time.

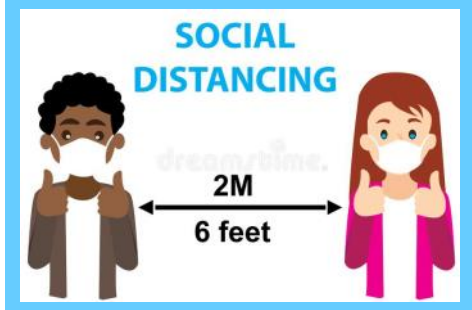

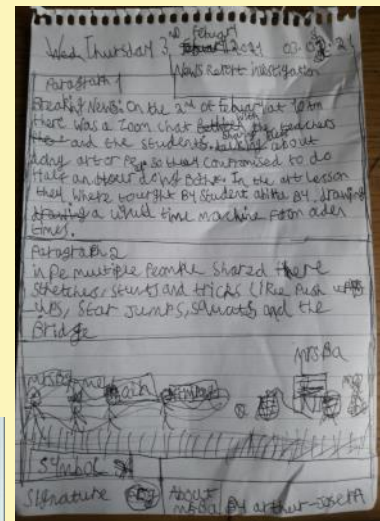
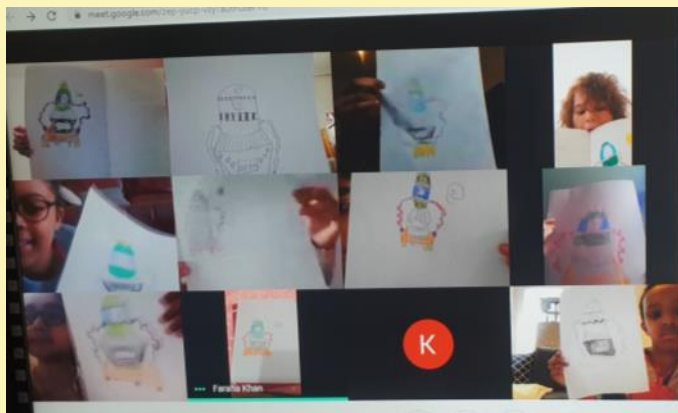


# ...Breaking News...Breaking News...
