

Reading

Every child throughout our school is expected to read daily at home with parents/carers for a period of time which is age appropriate. To track this, and to form strong home school links every child is provided with a reading record where home and school can comment on the progress the child makes.

Guided reading occurs every day in all classes from Reception to Year 6 using the **Oxford Reading Tree Scheme**. In Nursery children read for pleasure with adults and peers and enjoy story times with props, puppets, masks and songs.

Regular reading and discussion of the texts read are vital in developing children's reading and comprehension skills this is focused on during guided reading time where teachers question and children debate.

Power of Reading – At Kensington Avenue key members of staff have attended training in order to ensure that literacy is taught through quality texts provided by the programme.
