

LEGO at home

As well as using them to build and count, there's loads of activities that can be enjoyed by your family using lego/duplo bricks! Using general household objects, we've put together some idea's for you to try out!

BRICK SOUP (PD, M, CL, EAD,)

Use water and any kitchen utensils such as whisk, wooden spoons, ladles, large spoons and an empty bowl or bath. Use the utensils to scoop, pour and measure as well as making music and sounds while mixing. Speak about what you're doing, the colours you see and try counting the bricks.



BRICK PRINTING (M,PD,EAD,UW)

Using play dough or damp soil, this activity is a fun way to assist children's learning to identify letters/numbers/shapes and words, speaking about what they have created. You can incorporate mark making by allowing children to use their fingers or a mark making tool to trace the pattern they print out with the Lego

Using empty cereal boxes/paper and some colour pencils and scissors children can create any shapes any size pattern cards to explore and discover pairing Lego bricks up to match their cards, supporting children to develop their fine motor gross skills, colour recognition, problem solving and much more!
