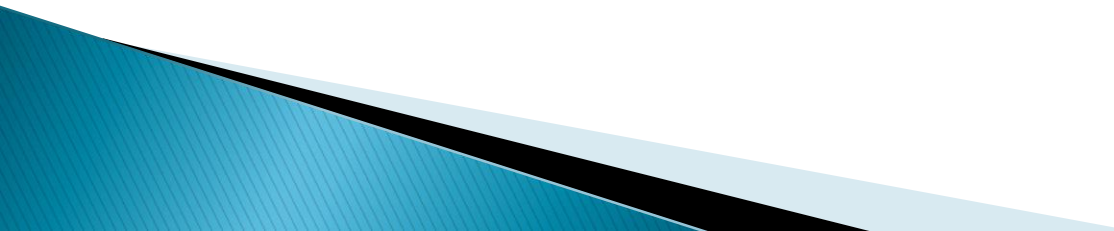
Selective Eligibility Test

- ▶ Wilson's, Wallington High, Wallington County, Sutton Grammar, Nonsuch and Greenshaw.
 - ▶ Online registration for the Selective Eligibility Test is now open – visit the website of any of the above schools to access the system.
 - ▶ Deadline Friday 4th August. Friday 16th June for requests for special arrangements.
 - ▶ For open evening dates please look on school websites.
 - ▶ Tests will take place on 12th September. Children who pass the first test will be invited to sit a second test.

Step 1: Getting ready – do your research

- ▶ Find schools near to you, use the map to find your nearest state secondary school.
 - ▶ Visit the schools you are interested in making an application to. Open evening dates and times will be given in September.
 - ▶ Take your child to the open evenings so that they can visit the schools.
 - ▶ Look at their websites/prospectuses.

Step 2:

- ▶ Check the admissions criteria for each school.
 - ▶ www.croydon.gov.uk/education/schools-new/secondary-schools
 - ▶ You can also look on each school's website.
- 

Step 3: Complete your application (Common Application Form)

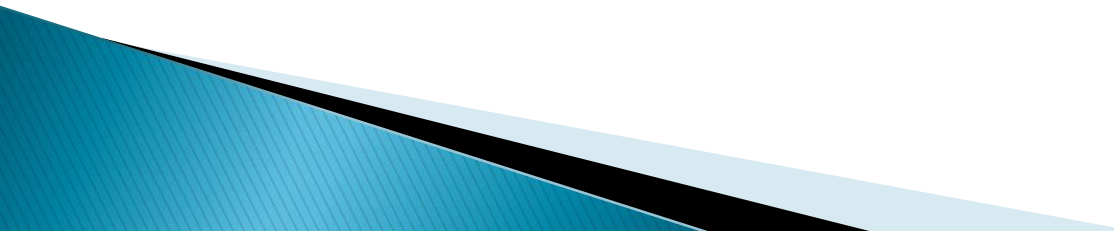
- ▶ Your school preferences are listed on the **Common Application Form**.
- ▶ Some schools require you to complete a **Supplementary Information Form**.
- ▶ These forms collect information that is not requested on the **CAF** and will be used by the school to apply its admission criteria.
- ▶ You get these forms from the school itself or its website. This form must be returned directly to the school.
- ▶ If you complete a **Supplementary Information Form** you must also complete the **Common Application Form** and return it to the **Local Authority**.

- ▶ There are spaces for 6 schools on the form.
- ▶ Put your choices in order of preference.


Closing date for receipt of secondary school applications is 31st October 2023.

- ▶ You must meet this deadline.
- ▶ If you miss the deadline your application will be considered after those who did apply by the deadline have been allocated a school.


Step 4: Receiving your offer for Secondary Schools

- ▶ On the first Monday in March 2024 you will be sent an email with the outcome of your application.
 - ▶ Accepting the offer – parents/carers must accept or decline the offer quickly. The deadline is 2 weeks after the offer.
