Here's a marvellous macaroni-cheese recipe for you to try at home from our caterer - Olive!



INGREDIENTS:

- 300ml semi skimmed milk
- 200g pasta macaroni
- 75g grated cheddar cheese
- 30g plain flour
- 30g margarine/butter
- 20ml double cream/alternative such as Oatly
- Salt and pepper.

METHOD

- Preheat oven to 180c/gas mark 4
- Cook macaroni as described on the packaging.
- While the macaroni is cooking, prepare the sauce.
- In a saucepan, heat the margarine/butter in a saucepan on a low heat.

- Add the flour and cook for 1 2 minutes - stirring.
- Warm the milk. When hot, whisk into the flour and margarine/butter mixture until smooth and the sauce thickens.
- Mix half the cheddar cheese and cream into the sauce.
- Season with salt and pepper take off the heat and set aside.
- Drain the macaroni and mix with the sauce in an ovenproof dish.
- Sprinkle the remaining cheese and bake until golden.
